RENEWAL NOTICE TO ALL TRADERS 2016 FOR 2017 TRADING YEAR

The KwaZulu-Natal Liquor Authority is advising all license holders that in terms of section 64 of the KZN Liquor Licensing Act 06 of 2010 as amended - a license holder must apply for renewal **SIX MONTHS PRIOR** to the expiry date of the license.

(However if you have not applied for renewal as yet, you still have a chance to do so until 31 December 2016).

HOW TO APPLY FOR RENEWAL

Complete FORM – KZNLA 19

– Available from KZNLA Head office and at all District offices OR by visiting www.kznlqa.co.za

Attach the following documents:

- A certified copy of the current liquor license.
- A certified copy of the Identity Document of the license holder.
- An original or certified copy of a valid and active tax clearance certificate from SARS valid from the date of lodgment of the renewal application.
- An original or certified copy of a clearance certificate issued by SAPS valid as at the date of lodgment of the application of a period in excess of three months from the date of issue by SAPS.
- **Payment should only be done once the Liquor Authority issues you with a reference number.**

Please note the following:

- A KZNLA inspector will conduct an inspection on your premises after receipt of your application to ensure that the license conditions have been met.
- Penalties for late payment of fees will be an amount equal to the renewal fee per month subject to a maximum penalty of three times the annual fee for every month that payment is late. If no payment is received after the third month after expiry, the license will lapse and will be cancelled.
